### **Education Database (ProQuest Central)**

Education Database (ProQuest Central) Access to over 1,090 top educational publications, including more than 800 titles in full text.

### **eLibrary Academic Platform**

General reference collection of periodical and digital media content specifically tailored for K-12 schools and libraries of all kinds, covering a variety of subjects including business, education, general interest, health, language arts, sciences, social sciences, and many other curriculum-specific subject areas.

### **ERIC**

ERIC Sponsored by the U.S. Department of Education, ERIC provides extensive access to education-related literature, including coverage of journal articles, conferences, meetings, government documents, theses, dissertations, reports, audiovisual media, bibliographies, directories, books and monographs.

### **Library & Information Science Abstracts (LISA)**

Library & Information Science Abstracts (LISA) Contains abstracts from over 300 periodicals from around 40 countries and 20 languages, providing comprehensive bibliographic coverage of the scholarly literature related to library science.

### **Library Science Database (ProQuest Central)**

Library Science Database (ProQuest Central) Access to over 150 top publications in library and information science. Specifically designed to provide full-text support for core titles included in the Library & Information Science Abstracts database.

### **Literature Online (LION)**

Literature Online (LION) Primary and critical text database for literary research at all levels. The collection includes full text of more than 350,000 works of poetry, drama, and prose stretching back to the 8th century through the present day.

### **ProQuest Central**

ProQuest Central A cross-disciplinary research tool with 39 databases that can be searched together or individually.

### **Research Companion**
