

## **Program Descriptions April 2024**

**Mother Goose on the Loose** – An interactive storytime for infants, toddlers & their caregivers. We'll focus on rhymes, songs, movement, & music to practice a variety of early literacy skills.

**Play to Learn** – A child-centered play program where kids guide their own learning through their curiosity and individual interests. Aimed at ages 3-7 years.

**Nonfiction Story Time & Craft** - Starting at 4:30 pm, join our guest reader for an illustrated nonfiction story time and a craft to follow. Each week will feature a new book.

**Where the Wild Books Are** – A storytime for preschoolers & early elementary. We'll focus on stories, music, and movement to practice early literacy skills.

**Little Hands at Work** – At the end of Where the Wild Books Are, we will have make-n-take arts & crafts kits for families. You can explore the craft in the Children's Room at the library that day or you can take it home with you for later! Extra kits will in the Children's Room for pickup after WTWBA while supplies last.

Little ones will socialize, garden, craft, snack, & read with volunteers while caregivers can visit and explore the library. The program starts in the Children's Room and breaks out from there.
