



Cozy Club – Stop by the Story Room for an afternoon of low-light quiet time featuring sensory toys, comfy seating, and soothing audio visuals.

Drum & Dance – Let's stretch, drum, & dance to upbeat music using rhythm sticks & stability balls!

Play to Learn – A child-centered program designed for kids 3 to 6! We will feature various play-based learning activities, such as counting manipulatives, building blocks, puzzles, and sensory/practical life skill centers. *Please be mindful that some play stations will contain small pieces. Caregivers that need to bring an infant/baby will need to take caution.

Reading Dragons – Join us for an ongoing reading challenge and collectable card game. Launch parties will include an unveiling of new cards, fun activities, and celebrating reading!

- **Tales for Scales** – A Reading Dragons companion program! Find your next favorite book, get some reading time in, collect a card, or play a Reading Dragons game with others!

Storytime & Literacy Programs:

Mother Goose on the Loose – An interactive story time for infants, toddlers, and their caregivers that helps build a variety of skills through rhymes, movement, and music.

Music & Movement – Move your body during this interactive music-based kindergarten-readiness program! Limit of 12 children per class, first come, first serve.

Reading Buddies – Looking for a low-stress, non-judgemental place for your reader to practice their reading skills? They can read to you or you can read to them or you can take turns reading. You can bring your own books to read or pick ones out with your reading buddy. *First come, first served.* Buddies are collegiate volunteers.

Where the Wild Books Are – This storytime, aimed at preschoolers, early elementary students, & their caregivers provides: stories, singing, movement, rhymes, phonemic awareness games, and a craft activity!
