

Program Details

Blackberry Pruning & Training: The Faulkner County Master Gardeners will give a live demonstration in our blackberry patch on how to prune and train your blackberry vines for happy, healthy, and productive plants. You can also learn how we trellis our blackberries at the library.

Master Gardeners Teaching Garden: The Faulkner Master Gardeners teaching garden sessions are now open to the public. Each week they focus on new projects, techniques, and the science behind healthy gardens. They meet every Saturday from 9 - 11 am. All ages and skill levels are welcome.

Great Backyard Bird Count: Join us for the 2026 annual global bird count. We will gather to count birds around the library grounds. After **Saturday's** bird count, stick around to **paint your own birdhouse!** You get to take it home! Free. Materials provided. (Limited supply - available while they last)

This is a two-day program. Come once, or join us both days!

Master Gardeners Present: Tree Pruning: Now is the time! Learn the basics of how to prune and care for your trees. This will be a hands-on demonstration in the library garden.

Seed Starting Party: If you have a plot in the community garden, now is a great time to get your seeds started in our indoor greenhouse. If you don't have a plot with us, you are welcome to come and learn how to start your own seeds to take home. (Seeds, soil, and containers provided)

Bonfire & S'mores: Join us in the garden for a bonfire and s'mores. A fun time to enjoy the garden and socialize with your fellow library patrons.

Make Your Own Pinecone Bird Feeder: We'll make bird feeders with pinecones, birdseed, peanut butter. Take yours home. Free. Materials provided. (Limited supply - available while they last)
