Homegrown Kids: Get your hands dirty and learn! The Faulkner County Master Gardeners will be facilitating hands-on learning where we will focus on garden and nature-related topics. Activities may include building, gardening, art, and other types of active learning. Weather dependent. We will meet indoors in case of rain.

Group Gardening: Join us as we tend our plots and care for the community garden. It's a great time to get your volunteer hours in by helping us keep the garden beautiful.

Master Gardeners Teaching Garden: Each week, the Master Gardeners meet in their new teaching garden behind the library. Stop by with questions and get hands-on learning experience. All are welcome.

Keep Arkansas Beautiful Cleanup: As a part of the Greatest American Cleanup (celebrating America 250) we will pitch in to help keep Conway clean and beautiful. We will pick up trash along Tyler St. between Donaghey and Washington streets, as well as around library grounds. Meet in front of the library. Light snacks and water will be available. Wear comfortable closed toed shoes. Gloves and trash bags will be provided.

County Resource Fair: In celebration of "Mindful May," several of Faulkner County's community resource organizations will be present to share information on how they can be of service. We'll be finishing with a group drum circle behind the library hosted by True Mark Alisandre. All are welcome.

Starting Micro Greens: Learn the basics of starting and growing your own micro greens. The greens we grow at the library are donated to patrons at our weekly Lunch & A Movie programs. Visit weekly to see how we care for and harvest our greens.

Ask A Master Gardener: We will have Master Gardeners on hand in the library to answer your questions about home gardening.

Master Gardeners (Totally Tomatoes): Learn from the Master Gardeners everything you wanted to know about growing and caring for amazing tomatoes in your home garden.

Spontaneous Art & Breathing: To kick off our first week of Lunch & A Movie and celebrate Mindful May, True Mark Alisandre will be facilitating spontaneous art and mindful breathing. Appropriate for kids and adults. A fun activity to participate in before lunch.

Bonfire & S'mores: Join us in the garden for a bonfire and s'mores. A fun time to enjoy the garden and socialize with your fellow library patrons.
