In The Garden (Greenbrier Public Library): Join the Faulkner County Master Gardeners in the library garden to learn about gardening and all the wonderful things the FCMGs do for our community.

Ask A Master Gardener: Faulkner County Master Gardeners will be in the Conway library to answer all your plant and tree related questions. Free soil sample kits will be available. You can bring in clippings of unhealthy plants and they can help diagnose your problem and suggest solutions.

Group Gardening: Join us as we tend our plots and care for the community garden. It's a great time to learn about the community garden and get your volunteer hours in by helping us keep the garden beautiful.

Master Gardeners Teaching Garden: Each week, the Master Gardeners meet in their new teaching garden behind the library. Stop by with questions and get hands-on learning experience. All are welcome.

Plants People Used Long Ago: The Faulkner County Master Gardeners will be talking about and demonstrating how various plants have been used historically in the region. ** This program will be held at various branches. Please note time and location. **

Tree Giveaway: The University of Arkansas received a grant to distribute 25,000 trees across Arkansas. We will have approximately 100 potted trees to give away. Types will vary. ** Note: due to this being a grant program, we will need to record what trees are taken, where they will be planted, and how the new owners can be contacted for possible follow up by the UofA **
